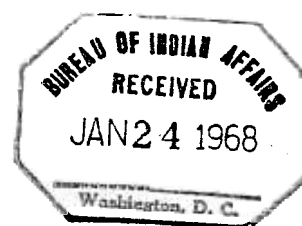


RESOLUTION NO. 68-1  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1 - LANDS



WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1 - Lands, adopted February 28, 1941, does not provide requirements reflecting standard use of tribal lands under assignment as a means of preventing misuse and non-use of said lands, and

WHEREAS, the assignment fees as determined in Ordinance No. 1 - Lands, are no longer sufficient to cover the total expense of preparing and executing applications and grants of standard assignment, and

WHEREAS, such powers as are enumerated in Article IV of the Constitution of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, have been delegated to the Executive Committee by the General Tribal Council by Resolution adopted February 28, 1949,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Executive Committee, in special session assembled, that Sections 8 and 10 of Ordinance No. 1 - Lands be and are hereby rescinded, to be replaced by the following:

Section 8. The assignee will make his permanent residence on the land assignment.

On assignments for agricultural purposes, the assignee and members of his immediate family and household shall plant, cultivate, harvest, and otherwise work the land themselves in accordance with an approved farm plan. An annual report reflecting crop yield and compliance with said plan shall be submitted to the Land Committee and Executive Committee for review. No lands under assignment for agricultural purposes shall be placed in soil bank, feed-grain, or any program causing the land to lay idle unless approved in writing by the Executive Committee. Subsidies derived therefrom shall be paid to the Tribal Treasurer.

Failure to comply with the above regulations will result in automatic revocation of the assignment by the Executive Committee within six (6) months from date of first notice with due recourse of appeal.

Section 10. A fixed land assignment fee of \$10.00 shall be paid to the Tribal Treasurer of the Oneida Executive Committee by the assignee at the time the Grant of Standard Assignment is executed.
