BC Resolution # 01-13-17-A Regarding Pardon of Roxanne McDowell


- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee is delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon and Forgiveness Screening Committee reviewed the pardon application of Roxanne McDowell at a duly called hearing held on November 17, 2016; and
- WHEREAS,** the requirements of the Pardon and Forgiveness Law have been fulfilled; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby:

- Approves the pardon of Roxanne McDowell for the crime(s) of felony child support, and notifies the Oneida Nation and its agencies that she is recognized as a member of the Oneida Nation to have all the benefits and opportunities available to all other persons as if the criminal offense(s) pardoned by this resolution did not exist. The pardon has been approved based on the following:
1. Probation completed
 2. Satisfaction of Child Support
 3. Fines paid in full
