RESOLUTION 1-19-77-A

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Diocese of Fond Du Lac has transferred the following described property to the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin:


In Re: Title to that part of Indian Claims 141 and 147 in Section Three (3), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Nineteen (19) East of the 4th Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeasterly corner of Claim 141 (see Vol. 136 A, pages 304 and 314, Government field notes for Division of Oneida Reservation); thence North 60° 51' West along the line between said Claims 141 and 147, a distance of 621.7 feet to the easterly line of lands conveyed by Warranty Deed Document No. 616978, Brown County Registry, said point being the place of beginning of lands herein described; thence South 29° 55' West, 50.0 feet; thence South 60° 51' East, 350.0 feet; thence North 29°, 55' East, 400.0 feet; thence South 61° 51' East, 50.0 feet; thence North 29° 55' East, to the Southerly right of way line of County Trunk Highway "U"; thence Northwesterly along said right of way line to the Northeasterly corner of lands conveyed by said Document No. 616978, and thence South 29° 55' West along the Easterly line of lands conveyed Document No. 616978 to the place of beginning, containing 6.428 acres, more or less, in the Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, the purpose of acquiring this property is to consolidate three (3) Tribal ownership of the land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee Hereby accepts the transfer of said property.
