RESOLUTION NO. 2-17-74-A

WHEREAS, the authority of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is recognized by the treaties with the United States; and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee was given the responsibility for the health, safety, and welfare of Oneida Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Income Maintenance is charged with addressing the needs of the low income needs of Oneida Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Oneida Tribes Human Service Programs have identified the need for an improved Social Service structure for the Tribe as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the continued and unaddressed issue of an inadequate Social Service system has contributed to the mishandling and sometimes neglect of such instances of, domestic violence, incest, child abuse, suicide, attempted suicide, alcohol, and other abuse as well as the break up of the treasured family structure; and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Income Maintenance has established through meetings with Brown and Outagamie County Social Service agencies, that the problems mentioned above, for the most part go unaddressed by their agencies; and

WHEREAS, THE Oneida Tribes existing Social Service Programs aren't adequate and the problems go unaddressed by either county.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Business Committee, hereby request from the State of Wisconsin, a comprehensive Human Service Program that will perform the task of bridging the gap of needed services.
