north half of the East 16 Rods of the South 20 Rods of Claim 118 in R19E, (parcel# 2169) and  
South half of the East 16 Rods of the South 20 Rods of Claim 113 in R19E, (parcel# 2170)

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe desires to have said property placed in trust for use of public assisted housing

AND WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe agrees to pay all remaining taxes due on the property for fiscal year 1980 through funds from the Community Development Block Grant program,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Business Committee requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Office to review the abstract of this property to determine clear title and to facilitate placing this property into trust at the time of closing.
