RESOLUTION 2-19-79-D

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. does have a Bureau of Indian Affairs Master Contract for education programs; and,

WHEREAS, higher education grants to eligible members is a portion of such Contract; and,

WHEREAS many Oneida students request but do not receive grants for graduate studies; and,

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs does provide such funds to graduate students through the American Indian Scholarships Services program at Taos, New Mexico; and,

WHEREAS, the American Indian Scholarships Services program has not responded positively to Oneida Tribal graduate student applications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to immediately withdraw that portion of graduate monies from the American Indian Scholarships Services program that would address graduate student needs in the Minneapolis Area; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds be contracted directly to Tribes in the Minneapolis Area upon resolute request.
