RESOLUTION NO. 74-3-4-A

WHEREAS, RIDGELAND COMMUNITY subdivision is a planned homesite development of part of Indian Claim No. 34 in Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 19 East of the 4th P.M., Outagamie County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has caused the same to be surveyed, subdivided and mapped as evidenced by Exhibit "A" herewith and,

WHEREAS, said subdivision is comprised of eighteen homesites and 1,553 lineal feet of road to be constructed and,

WHEREAS, due to the lack of Tribal funds the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is unable to finance the construction of the subject road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in regular session assembled hereby request that the construction of the subject road be undertaken by the Indian Road Department.

### CERTIFICATION

, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Tribal Business Committee hereby certify that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is composed of 9 members, of whom 5 being present constituted a quorum at a meeting duly called, convened, and held on this 4 day of March 1974; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by an affirmative vote of 7 for and 0 against, 0 not voting, and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
