

RESOLUTION

April 30, 1965

WHEREAS, the present Constitution and by-laws of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin provides that the same may be amended by a majority vote of qualified voters of the Tribe voting at an election called for that purpose by the Secretary of the Interior, provided that at least 30% of those entitled to vote shall vote in such election.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman shall forthwith petition the Secretary of the Interior to promptly call an election for the purpose of amending the present Constitution and by-laws of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in the form submitted with this resolution.
