WHEREAS, Indian Public Health Services provided a well and septic system to be installed and,

WHEREAS, through the Home Improvement Program, Bureau of Indian Affairs, provided a bathroom addition, complete with all bathroom utilities, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin directed Indian Public Health and the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide \_\_\_\_\_, enrolled Oneida Tribal member, and

WHEREAS, these services are for the benefit of Oneida Tribal members,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that \_\_\_\_\_ agree that for the consideration of the above provided services that if their taxable property where the bathroom, well and septic system are located is transferred by sale, gift or any other manner to non-Oneida Tribal members that a pro-rated amount for the above services provided by Indian Public Health and the Bureau of Indian Affairs be returned to the Oneida Tribe for the purpose of providing similar services to Oneida Tribal members.
