RESOLUTION 6-14-95-B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain and build a solid educational foundation by addressing the human needs of all members throughout the circle of life, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe does not currently have a program specifically targeted to meet the special vocational rehabilitation and training needs of disabled Native Americans, and

WHEREAS, approximately 40% of the Oneida Indian reservation population has one or more disabilities as defined by Section 369.4 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe through the Oneida Career Center and the Oneida Jobs Training Program would like to implement a Vocational Rehabilitation Program to meet the educational and employment needs of Indians with disabilities.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorizes and submits this application to the U.S. Department of Education for a Vocational Rehabilitation Service Project for American Indians with Disabilities.
