

RESOLUTION NO. 6-18-79-A

Whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs affirms that direct access to a wide range of library/media/information programs is intrinsic in federal obligations to American Indian and other Native Peoples, and

Whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs recognizes that the availability and use of accurate information is a necessary precondition for self-determination and an improved quality of life in Indian communities, and

Whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs acknowledges that its administration of a federally mandated education system requires that provision of top quality library/media/information programs as an integral part of the system, and

Therefore be it resolved that Bureau of Indian Affairs develop a budget line item for the implementation of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Plan for the Improvement of Library/Media/Information Programs.
