## RESOLUTION 6-27-77-A

WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Intertribal Council, Inc has identified a need for a Native American Group Home to provide for the care of troubled youth and

WHEREAS, there are presently insufficient alternatives to institutional care existing in the GLITC Inc. service area, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs will award the sum of \$50,000.00 to GLITC Inc. to develop to the point of occupancy and full operation a group home for Indian Youth on or adjacent to a Wisconsin Indian reservation, pending approval of the 10 Wisconsin Tribes,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in session, that a program be developed utilizing the funds through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Group Home development.

### CERTIFICATION
