

RESOLUTION NO. 2

WHEREAS, through the fiscal year 1951 an annual distribution of \$1,800 has been made to the members of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin under Article VI of the Treaty of November 11, 1794, 7 Stat. 44, with the Six Nations of New York, and

WHEREAS, no distribution of these funds could be made through Bureau of Indian Affairs facilities during the 10 year period (F.Y. 1952 through F.Y. 1961) due to reduction in personnel at the Great Lakes Agency and the time and work involved in record keeping and distributing \$1,800 annually to approximately 3,600 individuals, and the Tribe was not equipped or desirous of assuming responsibility and work in making the distribution, and

WHEREAS, over the 10 year period the sum of \$18,000 has accumulated in a non-interest-bearing account to the credit of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin/the U. S. Treasury, and


WHEREAS, this General Council in assembly feels it is only good business and in the best interests of all living Oneidas of Wisconsin affiliation to have this accumulated funds invested in Government Series H bonds or other Government Securities, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the ~~SN~~ Treasurer of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin be empowered to execute a voucher or other required document to accomplish the withdrawal of the \$18,000 from the U. S. Treasury and on receipt of check for this amount that the Executive Officers of the Council are authorized to invest this entire amount in Series H bonds, or other Government securities drawing the most interest and on behalf of the Tribe as a whole.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, hereby certify that in a General Council assemblage of 55 members of whom 50 constitute a quorum were present at a meeting, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held on this third day of July, 1961, and that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 49 (opposing vote of 1) and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
