WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin have a great need to develop their Economic and Industrial base,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe does not have the resources to hire a developer for Economic and Industrial projects,

WHEREAS, the development of Economic and Industrial Project for the Oneida Tribe is dependent on a full time continuing effort.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe hereby requests the BIA to assign to the Oneida Tribe a full time Economic and Industrial development person. That this developer be a qualified GS 12 or better to seek out Industrial prospects for the Oneida Industrial Park, Economic projects, and to resolve the Standing Stone situation.
