## RESOLUTION # 7-16-93-B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined by the results of the Tribal Housing needs survey, which was completed in 1992-93, that there is a need to assist the housing needs of the low-income, handicapped elderly of the Oneida Tribe.

WHEREAS, federal HUD Indian HOME program will provide assistance based upon a national competition for home construction and rehabilitation. The Oneida Housing Department will provide leverage support for this proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe will submit a grant application to the Chicago regional office of HUD Indian programs for consideration of funding of Oneida elderly home application for 1993-94.
