**RESOLUTION # 7-18-86-F**

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has an interest in lands located on Private Claim 61, Section 17, T 23N, R 19E, Town of Oneida, Oneida Indian Reservation, in Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee wishes to grant the approximately 515 foot long and 14 foot wide area of land to James and Diane Garsow, and James and Diane Garsow agree to accept this easement for a right-of-way for roadway purposes in and upon the attached described land, and
- WHEREAS, the easement will be granted with the following limitation: that grantee shall maintain the road with gravel at least once per year, as needed, subject to a recommendation by an Oneida tribal representative, so long as said easement is used for its express purpose as is described in the "Grant of Easement for Right-of-Way".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves an easement for an area used as an access to Srminary Road for the purposes stated in the "Grant of Easement for Right-of-Way".
