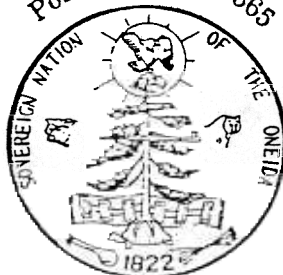


RESOLUTION 8-16-82-c

- WHEREAS, it is national policy to provide full Indian participation in the education of Indian people, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is vitally concerned about the education of its youth, and
- WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 allows Indian tribes to enter into a contract to plan, conduct, and administer education programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to continue administering the Tribal School and the following programs:
1. Johnson O'Malley
 2. Title IV, B and C
 3. Special Education
 4. 638 Contract
 5. Title I

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the the Tribal Chairman be authorized to sign the necessary contracting documents for FY 1982-83.
