RESOLUTION

AUGUST 18, 1975

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, INC., IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AND/OR FACILITATING BETTER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEARLY 1000 ONEIDA STUDENTS, AND

WHEREAS, IT IS THE INTENT OF THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN INC., TO OPTIMALLY ADMINISTER AND MANAGE ALL PROGRAMS DIRECTLY AFFECTING MEMBERSHIP, AND

WHEREAS, THE SELF-DETERMINATION POLICY BECOMES MANIFEST WITH SUCH SELF DIRECTION AND IMPLEMENTATION,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, INC., WILL CONTRACT WITH THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS FOR THE FOLLOWING CATEGORICAL MONIES:

JOHNSON-O'MALLEY FOR F.Y. 1976

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS FOR SUCH CONTRACT WILL TAKE PLACE DURING THE 1st WEEK IN SEPTEMBER AT ONEIDA WISCONSIN.

THE UNDERSIGNED, AS SECRETARY OF THE ONEIDA TRIBAL BUSINESS COMMITTEE HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE ONEIDA TRIBAL BUSINESS COMMITTEE IS COMPOSED OF 9 MEMBERS OF WHOM 5 CONSTITUTE A QUORUM: AT A MEETING DULY CALLED, NOTICED AND HELD ON THE 18 DAY OF August 1975, THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY A VOTE OF 7 FOR, 0 AGAINST AND 0 ABSTENTIONS.
