WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is in the process of acquiring a garbage truck to be operated for the benefit of Tribal members.

WHEREAS, other vehicles and heavy equipment are available to the Tribe at no charge from G.S.A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee delegate the Tribal Chairman to establish and implement a Department of Transportation for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
