

RESOLUTION NO. 8-20-82-C

WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, Article IV (F) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available Tribal funds for public purposes, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has recently purchased the following described parcel: Oneida on Stop

All that part of Claim One hundred forty six (146) in Section Four (4), Township 23 North, Range 19 East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, lying between the center line of Highway 54 and the center line of new State Trunk Highway 54, as now relocated and lying directly West of the property described in a quit-claim deed by the above named grantor to the above named grantees as described in Volume 396 of Deed on page 583 Outagamie County Records, the intention being to convey all of the remaining property owned by the grantor between the two center lines of old Highway 54 and the new relocation of Highway 54 and being triangular in shape.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT - - -

The Oneida Business Committee in Special Session assembled, requests the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency to proceed in the Trust Acquisition of the above described parcel of land.
