
RESOLUTION NO. 09-09-98-C (see Resolution #9-21-94E) DNR Financial Assistance Application Resolution

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has determined that the overall goal of the Oneida Nation is to protect, maintain and improve the standard of living and the environment in which the Oneida people live, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has established the Oneida Environmental Health and Safety Department to "effectively promote a respect for our environment using our abilities to plan, educate, and regulate with the cooperation of the Oneida Community", and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe hereby requests financial assistance under s. 159.23, Wis. Stats., Chapter NR 542 and Chapter NR544, Wis. Adm. Code, for the purpose of planning, constructing or operating a recycling program with one or more components specified in s.159.11(2)(a) to (h), Wis. Stats., to further the Tribe's effort of reaching its overall goals.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby authorizes the Chairperson of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, to act on its behalf to; submit an application to the Department of Natural Resources for financial assistance under s.159.23, Wis. Stats., Chapter NR542 and Chapter NR544, Wis. Adm. Code; sign necessary documents; and submit a final report.
