RESOLUTION NO. 9-18-96-G

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Penelope Hernandez, #5977, a tribal member and Jesus Hernandez, a non-tribal member, residing at N7169 Path of the Wolf, Oneida, WI 54155, has submitted an application for a long-term lease for residential purposes, more particularly described as follows: **RL-2781(96)** Lot 23 of the Southwest 1/4 Northwest 1/4, T23N, R19E, Towns of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the Southwest 1/4-Northwest 1/4, Section 4, T 23 N., R 19 E; thence N89 degrees 10'16"E, 1,323.00 feet along the north line of the said Southwest 1/4 Northwest 1/4; thence S0 degrees 55'30"W, 1,038.11 feet to the north right-of-way of Old Seymour Road, thence N 81 degrees 07'-04"W, 306.14 feet along said right-of-way; thence N 87 degrees 00'54"W, 1,021.85 feet along said right-of-way, to the west line of said Southwest 1/4 Northwest 1/4; thence N 1 degree 03'01"E, 918 feet along said west line to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 1,278,620 square feet/29.35 acres, more or less. Road dedication contains 139,992 square feet/3.21 acres, more or less. (Lot 23 contains .31 acres, more or less)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in regular session assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, to review and approve the lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539), as amended, 25 U.S.C. 415, for the above-described land with a 25-year term which shall automatically and without notice renew for an additional term of 25 years, annual rent due at 1/2 fair market rental, to be determined by an appraisal, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
