



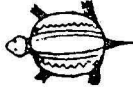
Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had persistently refused to aid them.

## RESOLUTION 10-27-78-A

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin that the functions of the Credit and Finance Division remain with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Great Lakes Agency, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe does not agree that the Credit and Finance Division should be transferred to Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc.,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs accept this resolution as being non-supportive of the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc. contracting for these functions in accordance with the requirements of P.L. 93-633.

### CERTIFICATION
