Resolution 11-1-82-A

Request for Bureau of Indian Affairs to place Tribally owned Fee Land into Trust Status

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has acquired or soon will acquire in fee status the following three parcels indentified as Parcels One, Two and Three respectively on the attached map and described as:

PARCEL ONE:

Part of Lot 22, Section 30, and part of Lot 23, Section 29, all in T24N, R20E, City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Section 30; thence S88 10' 46"W, 847.67 feet along the south line of said Section 30 to the intersection with the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence N01 36' 53"W, 950.37 feet along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the point of beginning; thence continuing N01 36' 53"W, 99.00 feet along said centerline; thence N88 10' 46"E, 852.08 feet to the east line of Lot 22; thence N88 10' 15"E, 462.01 feet; thence S01 22' 26"E, 99.00 feet; thence S88 10' 46"W, 851.67 feet to the point of beginning.

Parcel contains 2.99 acres more or less.

Excepting therfrom any lands previously conveyed for road purposes, and except Lot 1, as described in Volume Eight (8), Certified Survey Maps, Page 115, and except

A parcel of land located in part of Outlot 1, Volume 8 of Certified Survey Maps, Page 115, Brown County Records, being part of Lot 22, Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 20 East, City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Section 30, thence N 1 22' 26"W along the East line of Section 30 a distance of 884.50 feet; thence S88 10' 46"W 207.90 feet; thence N 1 22' 26"W 66.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing N 1 22' 26"W 99.00 feet; thence S88 10' 46"W 459.42 feet; thence

S 1 38'07"E 99.00 feet; thence N88 10'46"E 458.96 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL TWO:

A parcel of land located in part of Lot 22, Section 30 and part of Lot 23, Section 29, all in Township 24 North, Range 20 East, City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 30, thence N 1 22'26"W along the West line of Section 30 a distance of 884.50 feet to the point of beginning; thence S88 10'46"W 207.90 feet; thence N 1 22'26"W 66.00 feet; thence N88 10'46"E 207.90 feet; thence N88 10'15" E 462.01 feet; thence S 1 22'26"E 66.00 feet; thence S88 10'15"W 462.01 feet to the point of beginning.

and PARCEL THREE:

A parcel of land located in part of Lot 22, Southeast One-Quarter of the Southeast One-Quarter of Section 30; and part of Lots 23 and 24, Southwest One-Quarter of the Southwest One-Quarter of Section 29; all in Township 24 North, Range 20 East, City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Section 30, thence N 0 11'31"E 297.00 feet to an existing 1" Iron Pipe and the point of beginning; thence S89 52'15"E 146.67 feet; thence S 0 12'03"W 130.44 feet; thence N89 58'44"E 157.52; thence N71 57'07"E 138.16 feet; thence N89 58'44"E 235.75 feet; thence N 0 15'38"E 199.21 feet; thence N 0 19'30"E 643.39 feet; thence S89 50'40"W 209.28 feet; thence S 0 16'13"W 165.00 feet; thence S 89 48'54"W 462.01 feet; thence S89 49'25"W 816.66 feet; thence S 0 03'30"W 5.92 feet; thence N89 49'53"E 130.06 feet; thence S 0 02'58"W 581.66 feet; thence N89 49'54"E 43.72 feet; thence N 0 02'58"E 25.00 feet; thence N89 49'54"E 146.67 feet; thence S 0 02'58"W 25.00 feet; thence N89 49'54"E 493.37 feet to the point of beginning and containing 20.319 acres, more or less.


WHEREAS, the above parcels are needed in Trust status for purposes of housing for landless Indians and economic development, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes due on these parcels will be paid for the year prior to Trust placement,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee with approval of the Oneida Nation General Tribal Council hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
