UNA DEVELOP TATEL

Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the Oneidas and the Colony of Pennsylvania, a resolution, the United States was made possible.

Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has no sustained Tribal income and,

WHEREAS the Oneida Business Committee, which has a membership of nine persons, serve on a non-salaried basis and,

WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe sponsors more than nineteen programs, from several Government agencies, which include HUD, DOL, HEW, OEO, EDA, SBA, BIA and others

WHEREAS the Priorities of the Tribe are not always followed chronologically because of the lack of Tribal income and,

WHEREAS the greatest need for funds fall in the field of Economic Development, Education and Land Consolidation,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an all out effort be made to apply for funds from private sources.
