WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has recognized economic development as a high priority objective to improve the economic conditions of the Oneida Reservation, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council employs a fully qualified Industrial Developer to attract industry to the 32-acre Industrial Park, and

WHEREAS, The present industrial development program is partially funded under Upper Great Lakes Regional Commission, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee is requesting that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Minneapolis Area Office, help support the Oneida Industrial Development Program financially.
