

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Act of September 27, 1967, Public Law 90-93, provides for the disposition of funds appropriated to pay a judgment in favor of the Emigrant New York Indians in Indian Claims Commission Docket No. 75, and

WHEREAS, Public Law 90-93 directs the Secretary of the Interior to prepare the rolls of all persons born on or prior to the date of this Act whose names appear on the membership roll of the Oneida Tribe, the Stockbridge Munsee Indian Community, and the Brotherton Indians, all of Wisconsin, and


WHEREAS, Public Law 90-93 further provides that for the purposes of expediting the enrollment of persons, referred to in this Act, the governing bodies of the Oneida Tribe and the Stockbridge Munsee Indian Community shall with the assistance of the Secretary prepare membership rolls of their respective bands. Applications for enrollment with Brotherton must be filed with the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency, and

WHEREAS, no part of the Emigrant New York judgment fund may be expended until the rolls have been completed and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, except the cost of roll preparation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Executive Committee approves the use of Emigrant New York judgment funds for the preparation of the membership rolls as provided in the Act of September 27, 1967, Public Law 90-93.
