WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of the Oneida Reservation was organized in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (40 stat. 984.), and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Council members met in regular session on the 15th day of November 1976, and


WHEREAS, Andrew and Evelyn Cornelius, enrolled members of the Oneida Tribe, wish to place their residential property in trust status for the Oneida Tribe in the United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Council hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to proceed to acquire said title to property,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the property described in Quit Claim Deed #627393, recorded September 22, 1969 in Volume 817, P.7 of the Outagamie County Register's Office be incorporated by reference to this resolution.
