RESOLUTION NO. 12-18-91-C

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:

A parcel of land located in part of Government Lot Six (6), Section Eight (8), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 8, thence S0 00'00" W along the West line of Section 8 a distance of 626.00 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel to be described; thence continuing S0° 00'00"W along the West line of Section 8, 171.00 feet; thence S89° 41'15" E 161.00 feet thence N0° 00'00" E 21.00 feet; thence S89° 41'15" 294.87 feet; thence N0° 00'00" 516.00 feet; thence N89° 41'15" W 25.00 feet; thence S0° 00'00" 349.00 feet; thence N89° 41'15" W 218.87 feet; thence S 0° 00'00" W 17.00 feet; thence N 89° 41'15" W 212.00 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, The above described parcel is requested in trust status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide future homesite, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
