- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:
Former Richard F. Rottier and Mary Rottier, a/k/a Mary G. Rottier Property
- WHEREAS, the parcel is described as follows:
Legal Description: See attached.
Tax Parcel Numbers: HB-376, HB-377, HB-392-1 (split)
- WHEREAS, the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing agricultural land use and will not be used for gaming purposes, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement,
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

All of Lot 14 and part of Lot A, Lot B, Lot 15, Lot 16, Lot 17 and Lot E, Section Twenty-six (26), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Nineteen (19) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, in the town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:
