- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect and improve the resources, standards of living, and the environment in which the Oneida People live while maintaining, enforcing, and exercising the sovereign rights of the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe, through the Oneida Job Training Programs-WIA Section 166 Employment and Training Project, assists eligible adults and youth in the development of identified employment skills which will increase the participants' ability to secure and retain full-time, permanent employment that will promote individual self-sufficiency and self-reliance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, in support of the Oneida Job Training Programs, authorizes and submits this grant application for a Comprehensive Services Project (CSP) and Supplemental Youth Services (SYS), to the United States Department of Labor/Employment and Training Administration, Indian and Native American Programs, for Program Years 2006-2008
