**WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and**

**WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and**

**WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and**

**WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain, and promote self-sufficiency and self reliance by supporting economic opportunities that will benefit the Oneida Community, and**

**WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe through, the Oneida Development Division and with community input would like to provide employment for tribal members, especially low and very low income community members, and**

**WHEREAS, that Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family will be strengthened by promoting the overall health, wellness, and self-sufficiency of all Oneida Community members, by supporting economic diversity within the boundaries of the Oneida Reservation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin-Oneida Development Division authorizes and submits this grant application with community input and support to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development -Indian Community Development Block Grant program FY 2001 for the purpose of securing infrastructure for the High Technology Park/Area Development Plan on the South Packerland Drive Corridor to create economic diversity and employment opportunities for low income community members.**


