Grant application to the Housing & Urban Development HOME program administered by the State of Wisconsin Department of Commerce Division of Housing & Community Development for "pass through" funding to rehabilitate

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated authority under Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that the overall goal of the Oneida Nation is to protect, maintain and improve the standard of living and the environment in which the Oneida people live, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Housing Authority (OHA) was designated the Tribally Designated Housing Entity under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 by the OBC, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Housing Authority has determined that there is a need for housing rehabilitation for current housing units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorizes the Oneida Housing Authority to submits a grant application to the Housing & Urban Development HOME program administered by the State of Wisconsin Department of Commerce Division of Housing & Community Development for "pass through" funding to rehabilitate 24 Oneida Housing Authority existing low to moderate income housing units.
