RESOLUTION # 08-26-09-A Tribal Wildlife Grant U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated authority under Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that the overall goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain and improve the standard of living and the environment in which the Oneida people live, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin established the Oneida Environmental Quality Program whose mission is to... "*maintain and improve environmental quality on the reservation in order to protect the people and the natural resource of the Oneida Tribe.*", and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin understand there is a need to establish a strong wildlife management and long term monitoring program as another step in stewardship of the Oneida Reservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorizes and submits a Tribal Wildlife Grant application in the amount of approximately \$200,000 to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife.
