



RESOLUTION # 10-22-01-A
Replacement School Construction Grant

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has identified Education along with Language, Culture and History as two of our national priorities, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin continues to support the education of Oneida youth through offering services that will enrich our youths self esteem and provide character building services in a safe environment so they may thrive today and in their future endeavors, and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin submits a grant application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs - Replacement School Construction Grant to continue on-going efforts of the Oneida Nation School System.
