- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee supports a program to increase physical activity for the youth of the Nation; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee continues to support the education of the youth in promoting a nutrition and health plan to combat the diseases in which the Oneida Nation battles such as heart disease, diabetes and obesity; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee supports a smoke free environment in schools, Tribal buildings and events; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee supports the Oneida Nation School Board's decision to apply for the Priority 3: Coordinated School Health Programs and Promotion of Physical Activity, Nutrition and Tobacco-Use Prevention to continue on going efforts to reduce the unhealthy dietary patterns, inadequate physical activity and environmental health of the Oneida Nation youth.
