





Kathy made a motion to accept the JOM By-laws Norbert seconded. Mark abstained Motion carried.

BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS MASTER CONTRACT RESOLUTION # 3-23-83-A

Mark made a motion to adopt the resolution # 3-23-83-A that states, "that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin request to contract and administer the following BIA contract programs for fiscal year 1984 utilizing the Master Contract concept: Higher Education Program, Employment Assistance (AVT/DE), Johnson O'Malley Program, and Graduate scholarships". Kathy seconded. Motion carried.

MUSEUM - Bob Smith Bids on Brochure

Norbert made a motion to accept the bid from Castle-Pierce for copies of 30,000 at \$2,750. Kathy seconded. Motion carried.

Kathy moved to approved the bid from Lori Block for the layout of the Brochure for the Museum at \$2,500. Lloyd seconded. Motion carried.

FIRE PREVENTION

Purcell will meet with the two Fire Departments, Oneida and Hobart. There is a possibility of getting \$6,000 from the BIA for fire prevention. He will bring back a recommendation on how the money could be used.

CIGARETTE SALES

It is the recommendation of the liaison's, Mark and Kathy to increase the price for a carton of cigarettes from \$6.75 to \$7.00 per carton and would go into effect on April 1, 1983, and another price increase from \$7.00 to \$7.25 on May 1, 1983.

Mark made a motion to approve of individual cigarette packs remaining at 85¢ Kathy seconded. Motion carried.

HOUSING RESOLUTION SUPPORT 3-23-83-B

Norbert made a motion to adoption resolution # 3-23-83-B that states, "that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby supports and endorses the Oneida Housing Authority's proposal for a Resident Training and Counseling Program and agrees that the Oneida Housing Authority shall manage and implement this Program as successfully as possible."
