WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida

Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the

Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the

Oneida General Tribal Council,

WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of article IV, Section I of the

Oneida Tribal Constitution, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee and Management Team have committed to a 7th

Generation planning process, and

WHEREAS, a budget for FY '95 has been prepared based upon the 7th Generation planning process,

WHEREAS, the budget planning process has incorporated essential steps as assessment,

development, management and implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: The FY '95 budget for \$158.0 million, as defined by the attached documents is approved by General Tribal Council for implementation by the Management Team, with review and oversight by the Oneida Business Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this budget will be reviewed on a quarterly basis by the Treasurer and the Finance Planning Committee with modifications to be submitted to the Oneida Business Committee for final consideration.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That any adjustments to this budget will be done in strict accordance to previous General Tribal Council directives.
