Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.



GENERAL TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION GTC # 7-11-94-D

	RESOLUTION GTC # 7-11-94-D
WHEREAS,	the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America, and
WHEREAS,	the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
WHEREAS,	the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
WHEREAS,	the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I of the Oneida Tribal Constitution, and
WHEREAS,	a uniform Buy Oneida First Policy is needed for the procurement of goods and services from Oneida Entrepeneurs, based upon a quality product or service at a competitive price, and
WHEREAS,	the Oneida Tribe, its agencies, enterprises and other subsidiaries shall comply with the Buy Oneida First Policy, and
WHEREAS,	a compliance officer is deemed necessary for the enforcement of the Buy Oneida First Policy, and
WHEREAS,	there is a need for an Oneida Procurement Preference based on an Open Bid, graduated as follows: 10% for bids to \$250,000, 8% for bids to \$500,000, 6% for bids to over \$750,000, 4% for bids to \$1,000,000, 1% for bids over \$1,000,000
	Where two or more Oneida Entrepreneurs are bidding for the same contract (not to be affiliated with, or a subsidiary of the other) then the bid shall be based on a Closed Bid, for the good of the Tribe the award shall be given to the lesser of the two bids, after the award is granted, the bid package shall be open for tribal member review, and
WHEREAS,	the incorporation of an Oneida Business Directory is to be used by managers and, all purchasing agents of the Oneida Tribe, and
WHEREAS,	the Oneida Tribe shall set-a-side 10% of all primary contracts not awarded to Oneida Entrepreneurs, for the purpose of making an Oneida Award, and

the Oneida Tribe shall make every effort to reduce bid requests (RFP's) to its lowest possible

form, for the purpose of making an Oneida award, and

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WHEREAS,	if it is deemed necessary for a Tribal Enterprise to sub-contract, it shall contract	t to Oneida
	Entrepreneurs, for the purpose of making an Oneida award, and	, , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , ,

WHEREAS,	a bid advertisement shall be placed in the tribal newspaper thirty (30) days prior to the
	procurement deadline for the procurement of contracts or services over \$25,000, and

WHEREAS,	if the Oneida Tribe is to enter into a joint-venture with an outside entity, the Tribe shall
	consider, all reasonable requests for a comparable joint-venture with an Oneida Entrepreneur,
	before entering into the jont-venture contract, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe shall abide by the policies and procedures as set forth in the Oneida Tribal Covenant of Documents pertaining to the competition between the Oneida Tribe and tribal members.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the "American Dream" be extended to all tribal members who wish to improve their quality of life and standard of living, through entrepreneurship.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that this resolution is intended to be in conjunction with GTC Resolution 06-23-93-A Private Sector Initiative, and this resolution shall supersede any discrepancies occurring, or arising from the Private Sector Initiative.
