

The Bureau of Indian Affairs was requested to review WHEREAS. and makes comment on the proposed documents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Business Committee approve the recommeded changes as stated by the Field Solicitor in the letter of May 12, 1975 to the Area Director with exception of Article III to increase number to vote to 250 persons and Article II to allow no duel membership.
