GTC RESOLUTION # 7-07-03-A

Resolution Regarding Format for Annual and Semi-Annual GTC Meeting Reports

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, on January 6, 1997, the Oneida General Tribal Council passed a motion which requires that Tribal Departments submit standardized reports for the Annual and Semi-Annual Meeting, and
- WHEREAS, the standardized format included: Mission Statement, Summary of Major Goals and Objectives, Personnel, Consultants, Training & Education, Business & Meeting Expenses and Travel, and
- WHEREAS, departments within the Tribal organization utilize different formats to report the above stated information, and
- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council recognizes the need to modify the reporting format to comply with the paper reduction policy and to have the format be compatible with the Operational Plans submitted by Tribal Departments in the budgeting process, and
- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council believes that the Oneida Business Committee should develop a new reporting format for the Annual and Semi-Annual Meetings which reflects a unified and coordinated approach in reporting the state of affairs of the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Tribal Council hereby rescinds the motion made on January 6, 1997 which specified what information must be reported to the General Tribal Council, as found on page 14 of the minutes from the January 6, 1997 Annual Meeting.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the General Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Oneida Business Committee to develop a new reporting format for the Annual and Semi-Annual Meetings and that this new format be implemented for the Annual General Tribal Council meeting in January, 2004.
