GTC RESOLUTION 7-07-03-B Resolution Authorizing \$750.00 Per Capita for FY 2004

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS. G.T.C. Resolution # 11-04-00-A: Adoption of Per Capita Plan Z - Fixed Per Capita Fund Option and Unexpended Budget Fund, will be fulfilled in fiscal year 2003, and

WHEREAS, the authorized amount of per capita is \$750.00 for every enrolled Oneida tribal citizen, and

per capita payments are made in accordance with the Oneida Per Capita Ordinance, and WHEREAS.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has begun planning per capita options, to bring forward to the General Tribal Council to consider, for the 2005 fiscal year budgeting process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Tribal Council hereby authorizes a per capita payment in the amount of \$750.00 for every enrolled Oneida tribal citizen for fiscal year 2004.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this per capita payment shall be made in accordance with the Oneida Per Capita Ordinance.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee is hereby directed to present to the General Tribal Council per capita options for fiscal year 2005 in time for inclusion in the fiscal year 2005 budget.
