OnikwÁhtalaʔ niwahsohkó·tΛ Swahyo·wáhneʔ - Red is the color (of) the Apple  
AtaʔkÁ·laʔ niwahsohkó·tΛ othahyu·ní· - Gray is the color (of) the Wolf

### Sample Conversation:

Ot niwahsohkó·tΛ Kwale·lÁ - What color is the frog?  
AwΛ·lá· niwahsohkó·tΛ Kwale·lÁ - Green is the color (of) the Frog.

OR

AwΛ·lá· - Green

(You can answer any question with just the Color, however, for kids who are older, it is good to answer the question with complete answer.)
