

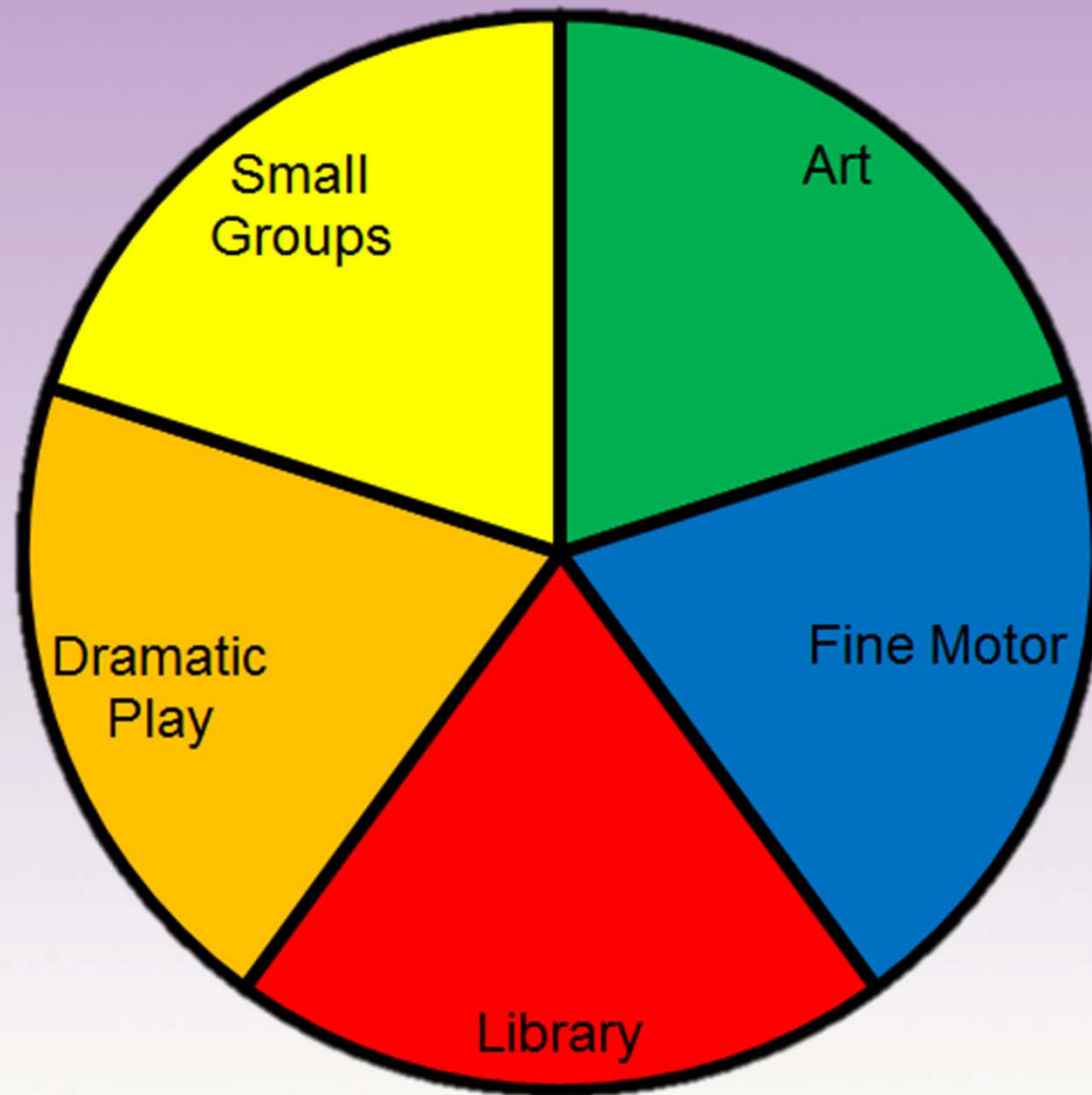

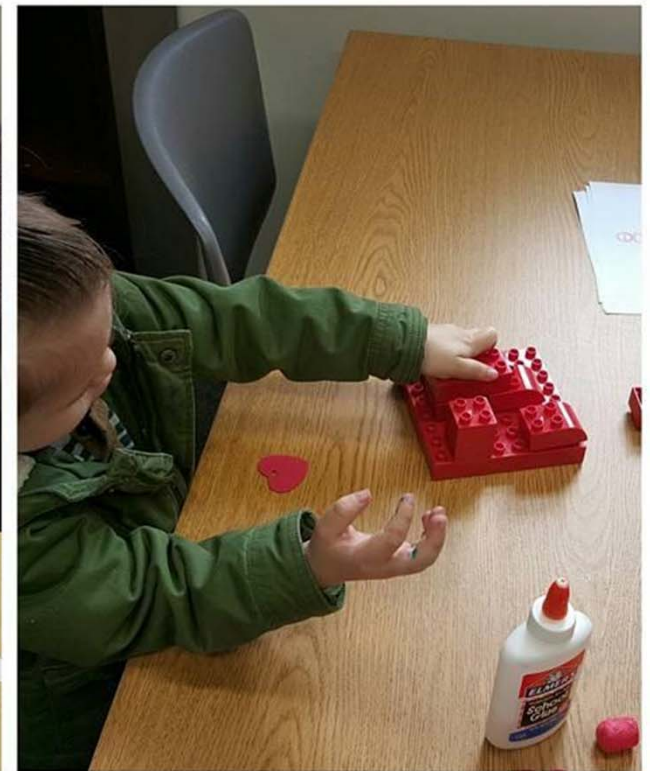
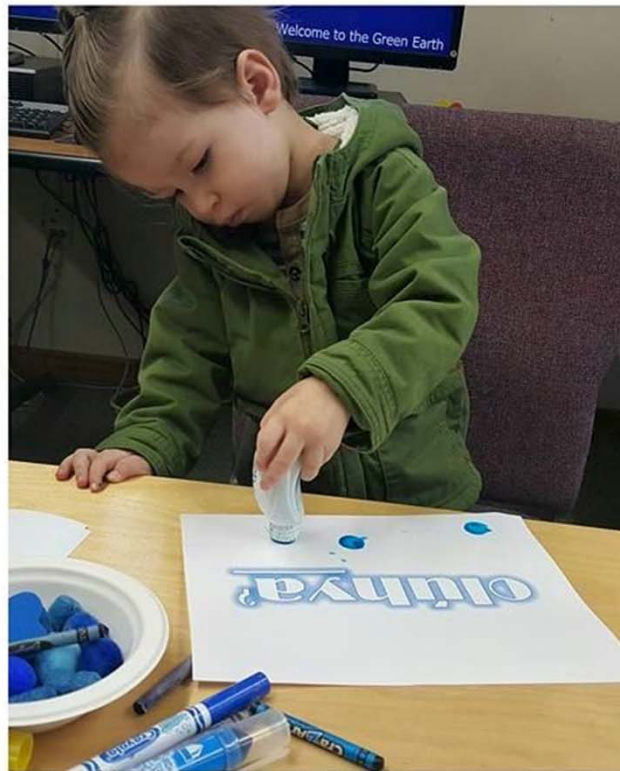
Teaching 2 - 5 year olds

- Talk to the children about the colors of the play food. Group foods by colors.

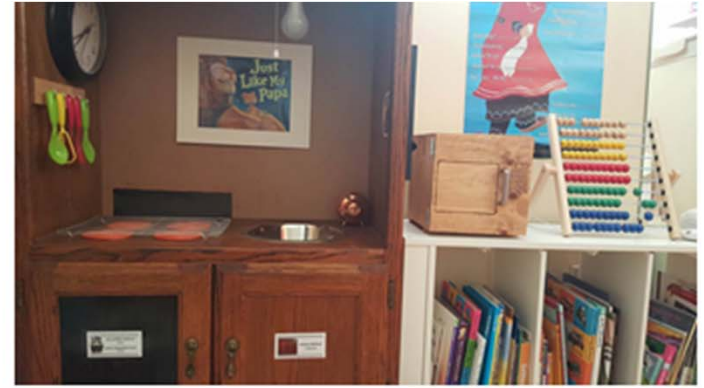


Small Groups

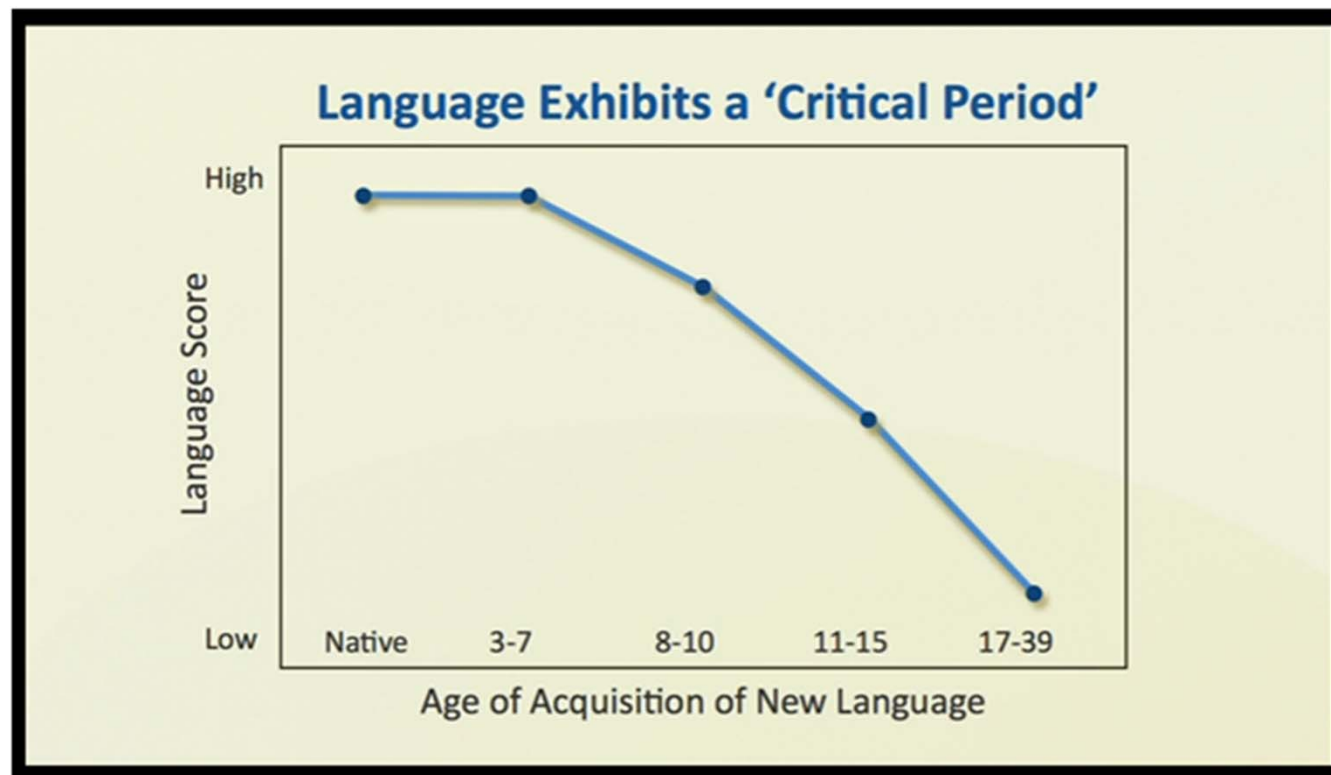
Future Goals
