Motion made by Althea Schuyler to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Irene Moore.

Council again discussed the business of the lumber James Skenandore received as a loan from Tribe. Treasurer reported that she had not heard from him, so council agreed that they would give him a little more time. Motion was made by Althea Schuyler to send him a final notice that his land assignment and loan agreement will be declared null and void, and action to repossess lumber shall be made, if the Council does not hear from him by Feb. 1, 1962. Motion seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Motion made and accepted to authorize Treasurer to pay Ray ? bill (fuel for ccc). Council again discussed bringing the Oneida roll up to date. Eva Danforth said she would contact the Ryan Funeral home to see what kind of records they may have. Irene Moore said she would contact Hiehl Funeral home.

Mrs. Moore reported that she called the lawyers in regards to the petition to President Kennedy and also had Mr. Archiquette talk with them. The lawyers reportedly stated that they didn't think it wise to do so at this time and Mr. Archiquette agreed that he would consult with them before going ahead with it at a later date. She also said that Mr. Riley wouldn't be here for the semi-annual, but would possibly be out here by Jan. 16.
