Grant Applications Process and the Role of the Oneida Business Committee


- WHEREAS,** The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Grants Office has been delegated the authority to administer the grants process, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin submits grant proposals on a continuous basis, and
- WHEREAS,** not all grant proposals require a Tribal resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Chairperson of the Oneida Business Committee shall have sign off authority on all grant proposals that do not require a Tribal resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: that the Grants Office will submit monthly reports to the Chairperson's Office, Secretary's Office and the General Manager regarding all grant proposals submitted.
