RESOLUTION # 1-19-94-C

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, to manage all the economic affairs and enterprises of the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: SUE PETERSON PROPERTY

All of Government Lot Seventeen (17), Section Twenty (20), Township Twenty-Four (24) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, LESS AND EXCEPTING the West Twenty (20) Rods of the South Sixteen (16) Rods thereof, and

The South One-Half (1/2) of Government Lots Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6), Section Twenty (20), Township Twenty-Four (24) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin

WHEREAS, the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide a future site for economic development, housing, recreation, conservancy, and agriculture, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certified that the local property taxes will be paid up to Trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians
