#### Minutes

Meeting called to order by Chairman Julius Danforth. Secretary gave report of March meeting. Motion made by Irene Moore to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Treasurers report read as follows:

Rehab Fund: \$450.00

Tribal Fund: \$708.00

Motion made by Eva Danforth to approve Treasurer report, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

George Webster was present at meeting to inquire about relocation. Council advised him to write to Mr. Riley and inquire of him when the area relocation man would be out here.

The following birth certificates were submitted for enrollment:

Randall Lee Doxtator, Mary Jo Doxtator, Issac Joseph Cornelius, Jr., Keith Gerald Metoxen, Mary Anne Meade

Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve the five certificates, seconded by Altheas Schuyler. Carried.

Secretary read report back from lawyers in answer to letter from committee, also one from Mr. Riley to John VanDenning in regards to fire runs on tribal lands.

A land application was presented for Casper King. Motion was made by Eva Danforth to approve the application, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Alex Denny was at meeting to check up on the loan he is paying to the Tribe and to discuss the status of his land. He explained that he is buying land from Simon Metoxen but has no papers to show. Council advised him to take this up with Mr. Riley as they thought this was heir ship land.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to reimburse Leslie Danforth \$3.00 for membership dues to the Deputy Sheriffs Association. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Sylvester Cornelius was at meeting to inquire about a loan to buy a house to move on his land, as his present house is beyond repair and he can buy one from Norman for \$400.00. Council advised him to contact the credit committee and fill out application blanks and bring them to the next meeting.

Motion made by Eva Danforth to adjourn, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.
