Resolution No: 4-7-82-A

Whereas, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is responsible for providing and/or facilitating educational opportunities for its members, and,

Whereas, it is the intent of the Oneida Tribe of Indians to ensure that programs affecting it's membership are optimally managed and administered,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Oneida Tribe of Indians goes on public record to oppose the dissolution of the Office of Education and the subsequent transfer of Title IV of Public Law 92-381 parts A, B, C and D to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Be It Further Resolved that the Oneida Tribe opposes any major budget reduction for Indian Education Act or Impact Aid Programs that affect Indians.

Be It Further Resolved that in recognition of the need for federal fiscal austerity, the Oneida Tribe of Indians respectfully request that Title IV, Parts A, B, C and D of Public Law 92-318 remain at appropriation levels consistent with fiscal year 1982 during fiscal year 1983.

Be It Further Resolved that the Oneida Tribe of Indians requests the administration to keep their promise and consult with Indian leaders on matters of legislation and appropriations that affect them.
