
Fee to Trust Resolution for the Former William Bain Property

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has be delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:
William Bain Property located on Overland Rd, Oneida, WI
- WHEREAS,** the parcel is described as follows:
Legal Description: See attachment
Tax Parcel Nos. HB-442 and HB-453
- WHEREAS,** the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing site for agriculture and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

Resolution Number: 5-04-05-D

The following land is located East of the Fourth Principal Meridian and contains 41.8 acres more or less, being more particularly described as:

A Parcel of land located in part of Lot 16, Lot A, Lot B and Lot C and in part of the Northeast One-Quarter of the Southeast One-Quarter of Section 34, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin.

Commencing at the East One-quarter corner of Section 34, thence S 0°-02'-04" E along the East line of Section 34 a distance of 1,413.45 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence continuing S 0°-02'-04" E 70.00 feet; thence S 89°-18'-24" W along with the South line of Lot 16 a distance of 1307.62 feet; thence N 0°-00'-39" W 164.86 feet; thence S 89°-18'-28" W 1,307.55 feet to the West line of Lot C; thence N 0°'00'-47" E along the West line of Lot C a distance of 894.37 feet; thence N 89°-19'-02" E 1876.48 feet; thence S 0°-02'-04" E 988.90 feet; thence N 89°-18'-24" E 737.87 feet to the East line of Section 34 and the Point of Beginning. Subject to easements and reservations of record, and including those Lands now being used for Highway Purposes.
